RUIA GOLD Swiss League: Mohota Leads the Pack at the Halfway Mark

After **four 14-board rounds** of the RUIA GOLD Swiss League, **Mohota** has emerged as the early leader with **58.81 VPs**, closely pursued by **Third Eye** on **57.12**. **Monica Jajoo** sits comfortably in third at **51.30**, while **Shri Radhey** and **Hemant Jalan** follow in a tight cluster just below the 50-VP mark.

The race for the top eight is already intense: **Deepadhaar**, **Team Burzen**, **Formidables**, and **Yarborough** are all within striking distance, separated by barely a few VPs. With four more rounds left and 28 teams fighting for just **eight qualifying spots**, every match from here on promises to be decisive.

The leaderboard is stable at the top—but the real battle is brewing in the crowded mid-table, where a single big win could propel a team into qualification territory. The second half of the league is set for a thrilling finish.

In **Ruia Silver League**, six rounds of 10-board each are over. The competition has begun to crystallize at the top. **United** have taken a commanding lead, sitting comfortably in **1st place with 95.86 VPs**, establishing themselves as the team to beat going into the final stretch. Close behind, **Six Shooters** hold **2nd place with 82.25 VPs**, narrowly edging out **Conquerors**, who are in **3rd place with 82.22 VPs**—a virtual tie separated only by decimals. In **4th place**, **Bidders** continue their consistent run with **80.13 VPs**, completing the leading pack.

With 16 teams set to qualify for the knockout rounds, these top four have positioned themselves strongly, both in terms of points and momentum.

Rajendra Gokhale from Pune booked a Mumbai-Kolkata flight when his Pune-Kolkata flight was cancelled. He had to pay a vulnerable doubled-redoubled 7-trick penalty for the same. It was an early morning flight so he took a cab from Pune to Mumbai. The flight kept getting delayed, but took off just before 6 A.M. He did reach in time. Others from Pune were not so lucky. One team had to cancel their participation.

Sixty two teams occupied tables for the first round in RUIA Silver on Friday Morning. Five of the sixty two North-Souths bid and made a 6♥ slam in Round one. This was the deal. South dealt and opened 1♣ on Navneet Swaika's table. Navneet responded 1♥ and East came in with a 3♦ bid.

East led the ♣2. Navneet won in hand, cashed ♥A, and ran the ♥T. East showed out. Navneet continued Hearts. West won and played a Diamond. Navneet won and played a Club to Dummy's ♣King. East showed out again. How would you have continued from here?

— Five out of sixty two tables bid and made the slam. Soham Sarkar, playing for Avengers Assemble, also reached the same position. The bidding was slightly different on his table. South passed 3♦, Soham doubled, South jumped 4♥, and Soham, in turn, jumped to six!

Both Soham and Navneet rightly judged that East was more likely to hold the ♣Q. In that case, they would only have 11 top tricks – four in Clubs, three trumps, the ♦A, and three in Spades. The fourth could come from a Spade-Diamond squeeze on East. Still they needed to postpone the Spade finesse to retain an entry to the South hand to cash the ♦King should East decide to throw all his Diamonds. Accordingly, both cashed two more Clubs. This was the 5-card situation with the ♣Ace yet to be cashed.


